MIE Experts are educators and staff who are **passionate** about their work, are **collaborative, change makers**, who strive to **empower students to achieve**.

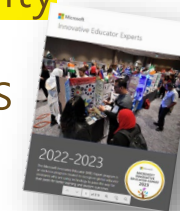
