With the rise of generative AI systems like ChatGPT, this adds another layer of complexity to the issue of academic integrity. These systems can generate humanlike responses to a wide range of prompts, including essay questions. The question is: If the AI is good enough to produce something that could be a student's work, how will we ever really know what is the student's work and what was done by a machine? The event will be collaborative and aims to encourage conversations around how learning, knowledge creation, and assessments practices can be reimaged to support the development of future-readiness in our graduates.
