Introduction

My name is Simon Patterson, and I work as a Digital Learning Specialist at Teesside University. I initially became aware of the MIEE accreditation during my previous role as a teacher, when I was pursuing other Microsoft-certified professional exams. 

Project Overview and Impact

For my MIEE application, I focused on my use of Microsoft OneNote as a digital notebook and e-portfolio, facilitating notetaking, task lists, and idea capture. It promotes collaboration by allowing real-time sharing and co-authoring. OneNote significantly improved my organisation and productivity. Sharing notes with colleagues and training attendees enhanced collaboration and productivity.


I've delivered training to staff, fostering their understanding of software potential. Many staff now develop teaching and learning resources using Microsoft OneNote and Class Notebook.
